Lew-Jacobs First Popularly Elected Supervisor

Palm Beach Gardens, FL - November 8, 2006 – Marilyn Lew-Jacobs became the first Board Supervisor to be elected by popular vote to the Northern Palm Beach County Board of Supervisors. Final results were not available on election night, as many voters in the north county area had to submit a paper ballot. Election results were released from the Supervisor of Elections office this afternoon.

“I am extremely honored and humbled by the outpouring of support by the residents of the Northern Improvement District. I will rededicate myself to earn their trust,” stated Ms. Jacobs.

In 2005, Northern’s enabling legislation was changed (Chapter 2005-302, Laws of Florida) to elect two of the five Board Supervisors by popular vote, while the remaining three seats will continue to be elected by Landowner vote. The other popular seat, # 5, will be up for election in 2008. Each Seat serves a four year term. The Annual Landowners Election will be held on November 15, 2006 for Seats One and Three.

Ms. Lew-Jacobs is a Certified Public Accountant with more than 25 years of experience. As Director of Taxation and partner in the firm of Goldberg, Jacobs & Company, LLP, she specializes in the audit, taxation, and financial review aspects of accounting.

She is actively involved as a volunteer with the following organizations as Director and Treasurer: Paint Your Heart Out Palm Beach County, Inc., Rebuilding Together of the Palm Beaches, Inc. The Lee Millman Respite Care Foundation, Inc. and the Palm Beach Gardens Cultural Arts Society Inc. Ms. Lew-Jacobs actively supports Alzheimer Community Care, Inc. She served on the Blue Ribbon Panel of Palm Beach Gardens. Ms. Lew-Jacobs is a member of the Florida Institute of Certified Public Accountants and the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants.

Ms. Lew-Jacobs has been a Board Supervisor since 2004 when she was appointed to fill the vacant seat of Hal Valeche, now a Palm Beach Gardens City Councilman.
