Landowners Election Results for Northern Palm Beach County Improvement District

Ronald M. Ash, P.E. and Adrian M. Salee elected to Board of Supervisors

Palm Beach Gardens, FL – November 19, 2008 – Ronald M. Ash, P.E. and Adrian M. Salee have been elected to the Board of Supervisors for the Northern Palm Beach County Improvement District from a slate of four candidates. Seat No. 1, won by Mr. Salee, was a special election to fulfill the remaining term of office created by a board vacancy ending in 2010. Seat No. 4, won by Mr. Ash, is a full four year term ending in 2012. The votes were cast at the Annual Landowners Meeting held at the Northern Palm Beach County Improvement District's Administrative Building at 359 Hiatt Drive.

According to new Seat No. 4 Board Member Ronald M. Ash, P.E., "I am pleased to be elected to the Board to continue the quality services provided by the District and to address landowner concerns."

Adrian M. Salee, the new Seat No. 1 Board Member, is also pleased to be able to focus on the issues facing the District. "I want to continue Northern's history of fiscal accountability and careful project management."

Mr. Ash has been a Board Member since September 2003. He has more than 30 years of experience as a trusted engineering consultant to public, private and federal agencies across Florida. Mr. Ash has extensive experience in municipal operations, as well as a background which combines design, construction and maintenance of public works and utility projects. He currently serves as the Florida Marketing Director for Brown and Caldwell, which involves helping nationwide clients develop and implement innovative, workable engineering and environmental solutions. Mr. Ash is a member of numerous professional organizations throughout the state.

Mr. Salee brings general management consulting expertise to the Board from a wide range of industries and organization types. One particular focus involves planning, writing and

implementing needed computer software to formalize his recommendations into working management “tools”. With both a Bachelor of Mechanical Engineering and Masters of Business Administration, Mr. Salee has worked with numerous national and international companies and government agencies including the Port of New York Authority, DuPont, the Alyeska Pipeline Co., Union Pacific Railroad Company, CONOCO, ALCOA, and the South Florida Water Management District.

In total, 12,026 votes were cast in each of the elections for the two Board of Supervisor seats. Ronald M. Ash, P.E. garnered the most votes in the first election with a count of 7,176 votes cast for him as the Seat No. 4 Board Supervisor. Adrian M. Salee garnered 11,871 votes in the second election as the Seat No. 1. Board Supervisor. The votes were verified and tabulated by the accounting firm of Rachlin, LLC.

The Northern Palm Beach County Improvement District is an independent special district created by the Florida Legislature in 1959. Its role is to provide services related to water management and infrastructure for properties in northern Palm Beach County.
