## **Matthew J. Boykin, Second Popularly Elected Supervisor**

**Palm Beach Gardens, FL - November 6, 2008** – Matthew J. Boykin became the second Board Supervisor to be elected by popular vote to the Northern Palm Beach County Board of Supervisors to hold seat No. 5. Election results posted on the Supervisor of Elections office show Boykin received 18,722 of 46,408 votes cast. The other candidates, L. Marc Cohn and Evelyn F. Parkes-Brier, received 14,160 and 13,526, respectively.

“I am extremely honored by the outpouring of support by the residents of the Northern Improvement District. I will take on the duties of being a Supervisor with respect and integrity,” stated Boykin.

In 2005, Northern’s enabling legislation was changed (Chapter 2005-302, Laws of Florida) to elect two of the five Board Supervisors by popular vote, while the remaining three seats will continue to be elected by Landowner vote. Each Seat serves a four year term. The Annual Landowners Election will be held on November 19, 2008 for Seat No. 1 and Seat No. 4.

Boykin is an accountant for Florida Power & Light Co. and previously worked for Bank of America. He holds a Bachelor’s degree from Miami University of Ohio and a Master’s degree from Florida Atlantic University. He is also a Certified Public Accountant. A primary focus is increased flood protection and fiscal responsibility.
