Lew-Jacobs is New Board President at Northern

Palm Beach Gardens, FL - November 15, 2007 – Marilyn Lew-Jacobs was elected as the President of the Board of Supervisors at yesterday's Board Meeting at the Northern Palm Beach County Improvement District. Supervisor Deborah Diaz was elected as Vice President.

Ms. Lew-Jacobs became the first Board Supervisor to be elected by popular vote to the Northern Palm Beach County Board of Supervisors in the November 2006 election.

Ms. Lew-Jacobs is a Certified Public Accountant with more than 25 years of experience. As Director of Taxation and partner in the firm of Goldberg, Jacobs & Company, LLP, she specializes in the taxation, audit, and financial review aspects of accounting.

She is actively involved as a volunteer with the following organizations as Director and Treasurer: Paint Your Heart Out Palm Beach County, Rebuilding Together of the Palm Beaches, and the Lee Millman Respite Care Foundation. Ms. Lew-Jacobs served on the Blue Ribbon Panel of Palm Beach Gardens. Ms. Lew-Jacobs is the recipient of the Leah Pillar of Community award. Ms. Lew-Jacobs is a member of the Florida Institute of Certified Public Accountants and the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants.

Ms. Jacobs has been a Board Supervisor since 2004 when she was appointed to fill the vacant seat of Hal Valeche, now a Palm Beach Gardens City Councilman.

Ms. Diaz, the new Vice-President, is a Certified Public Accountant and is a principal at Rampell & Rampell, P.A. in Palm Beach. She has been in private practice since 1982 in Palm Beach County and has served on numerous Boards and Committees throughout the County, including the Board of Directors at Riverside National Bank.
